- All abstracts will be evaluated for possible acceptance. Relevance to the theme of the Symposium and originality of approach are among the major criteria for the acceptance of papers and workshops.
- The Secretariat will inform proposers by 15 January 2007 whether their proposals have been accepted. The Secretariat reserves the right to decline proposals without assigning reasons.
